Mobile + Cloud: more a fashion

- Cloud Computing mainly for businesses
 - IT outsourcing, storage, computing;
 - For its scalability and robustness etc.
- From individual end-user perspective, no much more provisioning than conventional server/service
 - Indirectly benefit from Cloud computing

Mobile + Infrastructure: more a realistic need

- Mobile device is intrinsically weak
 - Weak computation power
 - Limited battery supply
 - Severe constraints on I/O
- Highly desired to leverage surrounding computing resources
 - Esp keyboard input, large display

Riding the fashion: Personal Cloud

- Vision: Every user has a Personal Cloud
- Personal cloud is a hub of all one's devices and also a hub to all one's subscribed Cloud services
- Personal Cloud should be movable, and ideally, easily coupled with the infrastructure
 - Reduce the latency
 - Better tradeoff between moving the data and computation
